Prepared on starting notes A, Bb, B and C on the E string.

Both fingerings should be represented.

- 2. Natural minor (both fingerings)
- 3. Minor pentatonic (both fingerings)
- 4. Major pentatonic (both fingerings)
- 5. Blues (both fingerings)

Candidates must play all arpeggio types listed, and from each of the four starting notes A, Bb, B and C (6 in total)

Prepared on starting notes A, Bb, B and C on the E string.
